Recycling Drop-Off Locations

The City has six locations where residents and businesses can drop off their recyclables. These locations are available to the public 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

- **Cardboard containers** are available year-round at No Frills on Valley View and Hy-Vee on N. 16th St.
- **Phone book containers** will also be placed at these two stores during the month of July.
- Placing any items, other than those listed, in or around the recycling bins constitutes illegal dumping and will be enforced with an \$800 citation.





Other Services Available to You (Located at the Council Bluffs Recycling Center)

Construction and Demolition Debris Disposal

To reduce your costs when building or remodeling, the Recycling Center accepts many materials for a fee. Regular household garbage such as food, clothing, toys, etc. are NOT accepted.

- Clean lumber—\$5 minimum charge/\$24 per ton
- Concrete—\$5 minimum/\$24 per ton
- Drywall, carpeting, roofing, siding, railroad ties, etc.—\$5 minimum charge/\$50 per ton
- Scrap steel—no charge



Household Hazardous Waste

Hazardous materials such as paint, stains, varnishes, caulking, drywall compound, roofing tar, etc. from commercial properties can be disposed of at the Household Hazardous Waste facility. These products, when coming from a commercial property are charged a fee and CESQG (conditionally exempt small quantity generator) verification. Call the Recycling Center for more details.

Swap Shop Program

Various items can be acquired from the Swap Shop. Items that are safe and in good condition, such as household cleaners, car care supplies and latex paints are available to residents at no charge. Due to the hazardous nature of the chemicals being accepted, the shop hours are the same as the regular RCC collection hours.
